- 3. Conflict is resolved consciously.
- 4. Love is expressed through care, attention, and responsibility.

ARTICLE VI — CHARACTER & VALUES

We live by the following non-negotiable values: - Honesty - Truth - Authenticity - Vulnerability - Sensitivity - Spirituality - Tenderness - Depth - Devotion - Discipline - Loyalty - Courage - Faith - Excellence - Love

Violation of these values requires reflection, repair, and recommitment.

ARTICLE VII — FINANCES & WORK

- 1. Money is stewardship, not identity.
- 2. Transparency is required.
- 3. Long-term thinking governs decisions.
- 4. Work is meaningful, ethical, and aligned with values.
- 5. Wealth must serve life, family, and contribution.

ARTICLE VIII — COMMUNITY & BOUNDARIES
